



Locating a Scholarly Psychology Article

Searching for Articles

To find a Scholarly Journal Article from a reputable Psychology database:

- 1) Go to the **Jackson Library homepage**,
- 2) Click on **Article Databases**,
- 3) Click **Psychology**.

PsycArticles - OVID 

PsycArticles provides many Full Text articles. From the News Page click 

There are two databases within PsycArticles. **Your Journals @ OVID** includes only those titles to which the library subscribes. **Journals @ OVID Full Text**, includes more titles, including those listed for sale.

Type in a few key terms or phrase. Click **Limits** and check the PsycARTICLES limit to see only those APA journals which are scholarly and mostly in full text.

PsycARTICLES

Click **Search History** then choose several searches to combine with the AND or OR buttons.

When a citation without full text is found, use the **Journal Titles** link to search and find articles not in full text.

PsycINFO - WebSPIRS 

Go back to **Article Databases, Psychology** section of the Jackson Library web site and choose PsycINFO. You must select each date range to include in a search, then click 

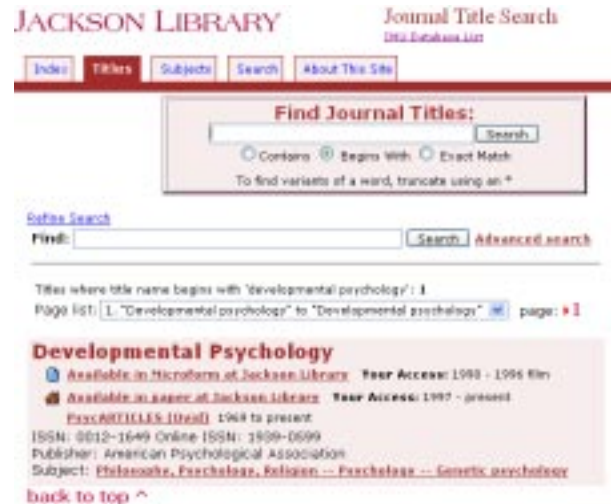
Type in search terms or phrase. In Limits box, check Peer-Reviewed to find only scholarly journals.

Peer Reviewed Journals

Use the Thesaurus or perform a keyword search more relevant searches. When a citation is found, use the **Journal Titles** link to search and find articles not in full text.

Searching for Journals

Journals in the Jackson Library are shelved alphabetically. To find a specific journal title in full text, use the **Journal Titles** link to search from the Jackson Library homepage.



Clicking the database link (Academic Search Premier, CINAHL, PsycArticles OVID, etc) takes you to that database and that exact journal title.

Choose the year and issue to see a list of full text articles.

Many databases have links to allow searching within a specific journal title.

Clicking on the **paper at Jackson Library** in the Journal Titles search results will not let you search or view full text. Retrieve paper copies from the journal shelves.

The Journal Titles link works great when seeking full-text for a specific journal citation.

If you can't find a specific Journal, then speak to a Reference Librarian or consider making an **Interlibrary Loan request**.
